Located to the south of Leghorn and separated from the city by the beautiful coastline of Il Romito, Quercianella is surrounded by the greenery of the pine groves and the Mediterranean scrub. In front of the crystalline water of the sea that sprays the rocks, Quercianella is a tiny charming village, where you can relax and enjoy yourself. Besides the beach facilities and the bathing establishments, this portion of sea is particularly appreciated by the sea sport lovers, as cliffs, pebbly beaches and small inlets framed by the scrub come in succession along the coast. The seafloor in the area is rich with fish, which makes it perfect for scuba diving or snorkelling. Sailing is practised all year round and the marina is a safe dock for small boats. Quercianella's beaches have obtained the Bandiera Blu award for the excellent quality of environment and services since 2007.



The club Circolo Nautico Quercianella is enrolled in the register of CONI, the Italian National Olympic Committee. Its sailing school, "Scuola Vela Federico Santerini" is certified by the Federazione Italiana Vela (Italian Sailing Federation) and is one of the summer schools with the largest number of athletes in the whole

Santerini teaches students how to steer a sailing boat, highlights the respect for the sea and for the environment and - last but not least - entertains learners with the games she organizes as well as with legendary "spiagiate", the fab excursions at the end of every cycle of lessons. The courses are held on Optimist, Laser, Laser Bug, 420 and Vaurien. For insurance purpose, it is COMPULSORY to enrol in the FIV, which is possible upon delivery of the relevant medical certificate. One free trial lesson is available for children who have never attended a sailing class.
